Dear Parents:

We are excited to begin our *“Lenten Challenge”*. The premise is simple – to embrace our Stewardship of Time – time spent with God at Mass.

Each student will journal and turn in their log to their Homebase teacher at the end of the 6 week Lenten period, due by April 4. For the younger students, parents may ask their child about Mass and fill in their responses on the child’s journal. We will then tally the results of each class. In grades PK3/4, TK/Kdg, Grades 1st- 5th grade, the class in each grade level with the highest percentage of Mass attendance will receive a prize. In Middle School, the two Homebase classes with the highest percentage of Mass attendance will receive a prize.

Kids do not need to attend Mass here at St. Mark. It could be at a neighboring parish or at a church that you might go to on vacation over spring break. If your child happens to miss Mass one weekend, just leave that particular box blank.
